1	Open platform, free to use.		
2	Proven track record in MOOC provision.		
3	Established partnerships with similar institutions.		
4	Broad general support for 'connectivist' style of MOOC, or cMOOC.		
5	Ability to customise appearance of site.		
6	Easy and intuitive to use, for staff and students.		
7	Ability to support large numbers of students, possibly up to 1,000 on a single site.		
8	Ability to support multiple members of staff.		
9	Content creation by reliable WYSIWYG textbox editor, with support for HTML for advanced styling.		
10	Support for embedding a wide variety of rich multimedia content, including images, audio and video.		
11	Ability to hide a course from public directories and searches (for during building / pilot phase).		
12	Large storage capacity.		
13	Sign-up survey to assess prior knowledge and, possibly, to assign to group based on level of prior experience.		
14	Course feedback survey upon completion.		
15	Ability for students to discover and self-enrol on the course.		
16	Ability to add and manage students by admin staff (for Sunderland registered students).		
17	Group management functionality.		
18	A journal or blog style tool with ability to make entries private between themselves and staff.		

19	A discussion board or forum tool.		
20	Ability to time the release of content (to maximise participation in discussions for example).		
21	Live webinar style tool with support for scheduling and unlimited participants.		
22	A quiz tool with support for all common question types and feedback by question as well as the quiz as a whole.		
23	An assignment tool which allows students to submit essay style documents, e.g. Docx, PDF, etc.		
24	An assignment tool which allows students to submit multimedia files, including images, audio and video.
